Nalcor Energy files submission to the Public Utilities Board for Muskrat Falls Review

November 10, 2011 – This afternoon, Nalcor Energy filed a two volume, 250-page submission to the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities (the Board) on the Muskrat Falls Project. The Board required the submission as part of its review of Muskrat Falls as the least-cost, long-term option for meeting the province’s future power needs.

Nalcor’s submission summarizes the system planning process used by Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro to establish the Isolated Island (current system) and Interconnected Island (Muskrat Falls) long-term electricity supply alternatives. It also summarizes the analysis which concluded that Muskrat Falls is the least-cost option for the long-term supply of power for the island’s electricity consumers.

The Government of Newfoundland and Labrador initiated the Board’s review of the Muskrat Falls development in June 2011.
